



## FAQ Regarding the CAHA Select Boys Camp

In order to advance to the CAHA State Select Camp players ages 17, 16, 15 and 14 and USA Citizens with permanent residence in California, must attend their respective Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) Camps and then be selected to advance to the CAHA State Select Camp.

In addition, all players that have advanced from their respective Select League Camps must register and pay for the CAHA State Select Camp by the deadline and participate in all scheduled sessions in order to be evaluated.

### What happens if I forget to register my player by the stipulated deadline?

The online registration system is set to close by the stipulated deadline. Players failing to register and pay by the set deadline will lose their position in the camp and their spot will be offered to the next (in order) Alternate in their age division and position.

### What happens if my player is not able to attend all of the scheduled sessions?

If your player is not able to attend all of the scheduled sessions he will be disqualified from participating and continuing in the camp. No refund will be made available. If you know beforehand that your player has previous commitments and cannot attend all scheduled sessions, please do not register and pay for the CAHA Select Camp. Send an email notice to the CAHA Select Camp Chair immediately. Your player's position will be awarded to the next (in order) Alternate of his position and age division.

### What happens if my paid registered player misses one of his scheduled session of his age division because of traffic?

Unfortunately, your player will be disqualified from being evaluated as well as continuing in the camp and no refund will be made available. It is the sole responsibility of the player and the player's family to schedule adequate time to arrive at the arena in time for your player to be ready for his scheduled session.

### What happens if my paid registered player misses one of his scheduled session of his age division because of illness or injury after the start of the CAHA Select Camp?

You must submit to the CAHA Select Camp Chair the required documentation from a licensed medical physician, explaining the illness or injury and the prognosis for your player's return to participation immediately. Once the documentation has been submitted and approved your player will remain listed in the camp without participating because of the approved illness or injury and will still get evaluated by the CAHA Select Camp Committee. The player will need to submit additionally the following information:



1. *The subject player's previous select camp attendance/results (SCAHA-NORCAL/CAHA/DISTRICT/NATIONAL)*
2. *The subject player's hockey bio/resume to show in chronological order the prior 3 seasons (who they played for and coaches' info)*
3. *(2) letters of recommendation, one from the subject player's current coach, the other from prior coach or scout, etc...*

No refund is available in this situation.

**What happens if I paid the registration for my player and he gets injured before the CAHA State Select Camp and is not able to participate because of the injury?**

You must submit to the CAHA Select Camp Chair the required documentation from a licensed medical physician, explaining the injury and the prognosis for your player's return to participation prior to the start of the CAHA Select Camp and no later than the set deadline for registration. Once the documentation has been submitted and approved, your player has two options available to him; 1) to withdraw from the camp completely and request a full refund or 2) to remain listed in the camp without participating because of the approved injury, and then still get evaluated by the CAHA Select Camp Committee. For this option only, the player will need to submit additionally the following information:

1. *The subject player's previous select camp attendance/results (SCAHA-NORCAL/CAHA/DISTRICT/NATIONAL)*
2. *The subject player's hockey bio/resume to show in chronological order the prior 3 seasons (who they played for and coaches' info)*
3. *(2) letters of recommendation, one from the subject player's current coach, the other from prior coach or scout, etc...*

No refund is available for option 2.

**What if my paid registered player is injured or becomes ill after the set registration deadline and before the CAHA Select Camp?**

As long as the required documentation is submitted to the CAHA Select Camp Chair at least 24 hours prior to the start of the CAHA Select State Camp, then you will be able to select from both options available as listed above. However, if the request comes once the CAHA Select Camp has started; the options are null and void.

**Furthermore, I would caution that there is no guarantee that the Committee will advance your injured or ill player based upon the information requested above.**
