



## FAQ Regarding the Process for “Out-of-District” Players

In order to advance to the CAHA State Select Camp players ages 17, 16, 15 and 14 and USA Citizens with permanent residence in California, must attend their respective Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) Camps and then be selected to advance to the CAHA State Select Camp.

### What if my player is currently attending school and/or playing hockey out of state?

Players playing hockey out of state and within the Pacific District (Alaska, Hawaii, Nevada, Oregon and Pacific Northwest) must tryout at the Select Camps where they play.

For Players playing “Out of District” they can request a waiver from attending the Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) and CAHA State Select camps.

### In order to qualify for the CAHA Select Camp “Out of District” Player Waiver, does my son need to attend the League camp (SCAHA Select or Norcal Select)?

No. The request is for a waiver from attending the Select League tryout camps because your CA player is currently attending school and/or playing youth hockey out of the district and is not able to make the Select League camps. When you request a waiver from attending the Select League Camps, your waiver also includes not attending the CAHA State Select camp. Your waiver request for your “Out of District” Player is for your player not to attend the Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) tryout camps and not to attend the CAHA State Select camp.

### What if my “Out of District” player is able to attend the Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) Camp. Can I request a waiver from attending the CAHA Select state Camp?

No. Once a player, attends the Select League (SCAHA or Norcal) Tryout Camp then they must be selected to advance to the CAHA State Camp.

### How will my “Out of District” player be evaluated if he does not attend the CAHA Select Camp?

Your “Out of District” player will be evaluated based on the information and documentation provided to the CAHA Select Camp Evaluation Committee as outlined in Step 1 and Step 2 Below.



## The CAHA Select Camp Process for "Out of District" Players:

With respect to your player's possible advancement to the Pacific District Camp, the process which you would need to follow is per the instructions noted below;

### Step 1:

*Provide the following Four-(4) documents for the CAHA Select Camp Committee to consider your request;*

**PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT ANY PHOTOS OR SCREENSHOTS OF PLAYER STATS FROM WEBSITE STATISTICS)**

Document 1: Cover letter should have the following:

1. *Why you are requesting an exemption? (Make sure to indicate your player's DOB, permanent residency and player position as well as indicate where your player is currently playing)*
2. *The subject player's previous select camp attendance/results (SCAHA/CAHA/DISTRICT/NATIONAL)*

Document 2: Subject Player's resume:

1. *The subject player's hockey bio/resume to show in chronological order the prior 3 seasons (who they played for and coaches info & make sure to indicate player's birth year and position.*

**PLEASE DO NOT SUBMIT ANY PHOTOS OR SCREENSHOTS OF PLAYER STATS FROM WEBSITE STATISTICS)**

Document 3 & 4: Letters of Recommendation:

1. *(1) letter of recommendation from the subject player's current coach,*
2. *(1) letter of recommendation from a prior coach or scout, etc...*

*(For the submission of the above information & documents ~ once you have collected all of the above, save them to one pdf file containing ALL documents and send to me in one pdf file containing all Four-(4) documents by UPLOADING the one pdf file into a google file link. (the link will be provided upon request)*

*(email your request for the google file link to [rvoulelikas@gmail.com](mailto:rvoulelikas@gmail.com)).*

**DO NOT EMAIL ME THE FILE DIRECTLY! Only files uploaded to the google link will be considered.**

*The upload to file the required documentation is due no later than January 3, 2022. Please note, incomplete information may disqualify your player from consideration).*



**Step 2: (Will not be available until sometime after the conclusion of the League (SCAHA & CAHA Camps))**

***Register for the CAHA Select Camp through the Rocky Mountain registry and pay the CAHA Select Camp entry fee***

Please note ~ The Rocky Mountain Registry will open after the League (SCAHA & NORCAL) Pre-Select Camps are concluded, sometime in January 2022. At that time, your player's name will be entered into the Rocky Mountain Registry and the registry system will generate an email invite for you to register and pay the entry fee for your player. This process will ensure that your player's name will be part of the CAHA Select Camp's list of eligible candidates for consideration for advancement to the Pacific District Camp.

**Furthermore, I would caution that there is no guarantee that the Committee will advance your player based upon the information requested above.**
